The Society had received 7 new notices of consultation from GBC Planning Department since the last meeting.

Of these, the two most interesting to note were:

Marycourt School: Following two previous refusals to demolish the former school, the latest proposal is to convert the former school into two dwellings. A previous separate proposal to build two new semi-detached dwellings on the school's car park/playground had previously been granted permission.

Gosport High Street: New plans for a 70 bed hotel. On the same site at the previously approved 54 bed hotel (16/00396/FULL).

We also reported to the Committee on the following developments of interest to the Society, which then led to further discussion:

- Haslar Gunboat Yards

And reported that both the GBC *Waterfront and Town Centre SPD* and the *Haslar Barracks Conservation Area Appraisal* had been adopted at the GBC Economic and Development Board 14 March 2018.
