The Society had received 7 new notices of consultation from GBC Planning Department since the last meeting, plus a consultation on a proposal to fell a Black Locust tree with a TPO on it.

Of these, both the 200 new homes at Daedalus and the conversion proposals at the Gunboat Yards are the most interesting.

We had submitted a response to English Heritage on their draft revisions to their Conservation Guidance, and a response to GBC's consultation on the newly designated Haslar Barracks Conservation Area.

We also reported to the Committee on the following developments of interest to the Society, which then led to further discussion:

- Nicholson Hall (question as to whether it could be Listed)
- HMS Daedalus, Solent Airport (report on FBC plans for the airfield)
- Brook Villa, 6 Crescent Road, Anglesey
- 139-143 High Street, Lee on the Solent (proposed demolition)
- Exterior Furniture at *The Victualler* in Royal Clarence Yard (fine imposed by Portsmouth Crown Court for failure to comply with GBC Enforcement Notice to remove the furniture)

We also gave a brief report on the main topics discussed at the 17 Jan GBC Regulatory Board, which included the following applications on which the Gosport Society had not been consulted or commented:

- 5 new 'Hangar Homes' at Solent Airport (decision deferred)
- New 'Science Park' at Hoeford Point, Barwell Lane
